AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL IN BOSTON TO HOLD ADDITIONAL REAL AND PERSONAL ESTATE.

*Chap. 146*

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows :*

SECTION 1. The Children's Hospital in Boston, incorporated by chapter forty-four of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and sixty-nine, is hereby authorized to hold real and personal estate to an amount not exceeding three hundred thousand dollars.

Additional real and personal estate.

SECTION 2. No building shall be erected by said corporation as a hospital building capable of accommodating or designed to accommodate more than two hundred patients at any one time, without the approval of the board of health of the city of Boston.

Not to exceed accommodation for more than two hundred patients.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE APPOINTMENT OF CERTAIN OFFICERS IN THE EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT, AND TO FIX THEIR COMPENSATION.

*Chap. 147*

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows :*

SECTION 1. The governor with the advice and consent of the council may appoint an executive clerk, and a messenger ; who shall hold office during the pleasure of the governor and council, and shall perform such duties as may be required of them by the governor or the governor and council.

Executive clerk and messenger.

SECTION 2. The executive clerk, and messenger, shall receive per year, and at the same rate for any fraction thereof, in full compensation for their services, the following sums, to wit : The executive clerk, twelve hundred dollars, and the messenger, eight hundred dollars.

Compensation.

SECTION 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Repeal.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
