**Chap.442** AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE SALARY OF THE SHERIFF OF  
THE COUNTY OF HAMPSHIRE.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. The annual salary of the sheriff for the county of Hampshire shall be fifteen hundred dollars, to be so allowed from the first day of January in the year nineteen hundred and eight.

**Chap.444** AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE PRINTING AND DISTRIBUTION OF

Section seven of chapter nine of the Revised Laws is hereby amended by striking out the words "fifteen hundred", in the last paragraph, and inserting in place thereof the words:— one thousand, — and by adding at the end thereof the following:— The number of copies of any report to be printed in any one year may be decreased by agreement between the officer, board or commission making such report and the secretary of the commonwealth, — so that said paragraph will read as follows:— Unless otherwise expressly provided, all the reports of permanent state officers, boards and commissions shall be included in the
