

AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE SALARIES AND EXPENSES OF THE GAS AND ELECTRIC LIGHT COMMISSIONERS. Chap. 2

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned are appropriated, to be paid out of the Gas and Electric Light Commissioners' Fund, for the salaries and expenses of the gas and electric light commissioners, for the fiscal year ending on the thirtieth day of November, nineteen hundred and ten, to wit: —	Appropriations.
For the salaries of the commissioners, eleven thousand dollars.	Gas and electric light commissioners.
For clerical assistance, a sum not exceeding five thousand dollars.	Clerical assistance.
For statistics, books, stationery, and for other necessary expenses, a sum not exceeding thirty-three hundred dollars.	Expenses.
For rent of an office, a sum not exceeding forty-two hundred dollars.	Rent of office.
For the inspection of electric meters, a sum not exceeding one thousand dollars.	Inspection of meters.
For the salary of the present gas inspector, twenty-eight hundred dollars.	Gas inspector.
For the salary of the present first assistant inspector, eighteen hundred dollars.	First assistant.
For the salary of the present second assistant inspector, sixteen hundred dollars.	Second assistant.
For the compensation of deputies, travelling expenses, apparatus, office rent and other incidental expenses, a sum not exceeding eight thousand dollars.	Deputies, etc.
For printing and binding the annual report, a sum not exceeding eighteen hundred dollars.	Annual report.
SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
