

SECTION 1A. The second sentence of section seventy-five of chapter two hundred and eighteen of the General Laws, as appearing in section one of this act, shall not apply to any justice of the municipal court of the city of Boston holding office on the effective date of this act until January first, nineteen hundred and fifty-seven.

SECTION 1B. Notwithstanding any provisions of this act to the contrary, the provisions of sections seventy-five and seventy-five A of chapter two hundred and eighteen of the General Laws in effect immediately prior to the effective date of this act shall remain in effect and apply to appointments to the offices referred to therein which are made on or after said effective date.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect as of the first day of September, nineteen hundred and fifty-five.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SALARY OF THE JUDGE OF PROBATE AND INSOLVENCY OF BRISTOL COUNTY. *Chap.749*

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section one A of chapter seven hundred and forty-five of the acts of nineteen hundred and fifty-one and section four of chapter seven hundred and thirty-three of the acts of nineteen hundred and fifty-five, the judge of probate appointed to fill the vacancy in the probate court for Bristol county, which vacancy occurred on or about August seventh of the current year, shall receive such salary as is provided by section thirty-four of chapter two hundred and seventeen of the General Laws.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on November first, nineteen hundred and fifty-five. *Approved September 9, 1955.*

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF PLYMOUTH TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO PROVIDE FACILITIES FOR HOLDING IN SAID TOWN THE STATE CONVENTION OF THE AMERICAN LEGION. *Chap.750*

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the limitations as to amount contained in clause (37) of section five of chapter forty of the General Laws, the town of Plymouth may appropriate a sum, not exceeding five thousand dollars, for the purpose of providing proper facilities for public entertainment at the time of the state convention of The American Legion, to be held in said town during the year nineteen hundred and fifty-six, and of paying expenses incidental to such entertainment. Money so appropriated shall be expended under the direction of the selectmen of said town.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
