

**Chap. 404.** AN ACT AUTHORIZING WILLIAM C. SAMKO TO REGISTER AS A PHYSICAL THERAPIST.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the contrary, William C. Samko of Worcester is hereby authorized to apply for registration as a physical therapist and the board of registration in medicine is hereby directed to register him under the provisions of section two of chapter five hundred and eighty-five of the acts of nineteen hundred and fifty-eight, notwithstanding the limitation as to time contained in said section.

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**Chap. 405.** AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RATE OF INTEREST TO BE CHARGED FOR FAILING TO WITHHOLD TAXES FROM WAGES AND PAY OVER THE SAME, AND TO THE ENFORCEMENT OF LIENS ON PROPERTY OF AN EMPLOYER FOR SUCH FAILURE.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Section 6 of chapter 62B of the General Laws, as appearing in section 1 of chapter 17 of the acts of 1959, is hereby amended by striking out the last sentence and inserting in place thereof the following five sentences: — Assessments remaining unpaid after the date upon which the same are required to be paid shall bear interest at the rate of one per cent per month, not to exceed six per cent in the aggregate, which shall be added to and become a part of the tax assessed. A lien established under this section shall terminate not later than three years from the date on which the return which was to accompany the payment of the withheld taxes was required to be filed, and until such termination may be enforced under and in accordance with the provisions of chapter two hundred and fifty-four in the case of real property, and the provisions of chapter two hundred and fifty-five in the case of personal property. Said lien may be recorded with the appropriate register of deeds, or city or town clerk, as the case may be, and said register, or city or town clerk, shall receive the same without fee. The commission may waive such lien and any or all of the other requirements of this section. Such waiver shall be in writing and shall constitute final and conclusive evidence that said lien has not arisen or has terminated.

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**Chap. 406.** AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE REIMBURSEMENT OF MEMBERS OF STATE AND LOCAL UNIVERSITY EXTENSION ADVISORY COUNCILS FOR EXPENSES INCURRED IN ATTENDING MEETINGS.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Section 6 of chapter 15 of the General Laws, as amended by section 6 of chapter 652 of the acts of 1947, is hereby further amended by adding at the end the following sentence: — Members of such councils shall serve without compensation, but shall be reimbursed for their actual necessary expenses in attending meetings.
