

ACTS, 1982. - Chaps. 392, 393.

Chap. 392. AN ACT DESIGNATING A PORTION OF STATE HIGHWAY ROUTE 122 IN THE TOWN OF MILLVILLE AS THE CHARLES L. "GABBY" HARTNETT MEMORIAL HIGHWAY.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

That portion of state highway, route 122 in the town of Millville shall be designated and known as the Charles L. "Gabby" Hartnett Memorial Highway in memory of Charles Leo "Gabby" Hartnett, a professional major league baseball player from nineteen hundred and twenty-two to nineteen hundred and forty-one, who participated in four world series and was elected to the baseball hall of fame in nineteen hundred and fifty-five. The department of public works shall erect suitable markers along said highway bearing said designation, in compliance with the standards of said department and as authorized by the federal highway administration.

Chap. 393. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF LYNN TO REINSTATE LEO J. POWERS AS A HEAVY MOTOR EQUIPMENT OPERATOR/LABORER IN THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS IN SAID CITY.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter five hundred and thirty-five of the acts of nineteen hundred and eighty is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any contrary provision of law or any rule or regulation to the contrary, the city of Lynn may reinstate Leo J. Powers, a former employee of the department of public works of said city, upon the occurrence of the next vacancy in the position of heavy motor equipment operator/laborer; provided, however, that said Leo J. Powers passes a physical examination to which he shall be subjected by the department of personnel administration. In the event of such reinstatement, said Leo J. Powers shall not be entitled to any seniority rights as a result of his previous service.
