Chap. 502. AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE ACTIVITIES OF MEMBERS OF THE PAROLE BOARD.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The fourth paragraph of section 4 of chapter 27 of the General Laws, as appearing in section 1 of chapter 994 of the acts of 1971, is hereby amended by striking out the last sentence and inserting in place thereof the following sentence: - Members shall devote full time to their duties, and no member shall hold any other salaried public office or engage in any activity which is in violation of any law or which interferes or conflicts with his full time service as a member during his incumbency.

Chap. 503. AN ACT EXTENDING THE TIME OF VOTING IN CERTAIN ELECTIONS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 53 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out section 43, as most recently amended by chapter 144 of the acts of 1973, and inserting in place thereof the following section:-

Section 43. The polls at every primary shall be open at least thirteen hours. Such hours shall be designated in cities by the aldermen or councillors, and in towns by by-laws or vote, or, in default of such by-laws or vote, by the selectmen. The polls shall in no case be kept open after eight o'clock in the evening. The polls shall not be closed before eight o'clock in the evening.

SECTION 2. Section 64 of chapter 54 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the third paragraph, as amended by section 1 of chapter 395 of the acts of 1972, and inserting in place thereof the following paragraph:-

In cities and towns at the election of state officers, the polls may be open as early as fifteen minutes before six o'clock in the forenoon, and shall be open not later than seven o'clock in the forenoon and shall be kept open at least thirteen hours. In
