Chap. 231. AN ACT RELATIVE TO CREDIT CARD FRAUD.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The first paragraph of section 37B of chapter 266 of the General Laws, as appearing in chapter 832 of the acts of 1969, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "inclusive", in line 45, the words: - or (k) makes a false statement in reporting a credit card to be lost or stolen.

SECTION 2. Section 1 of chapter 267 of the General Laws, as appearing in the Tercentenary Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "property", in line 7, the following words: - or a credit card.

Chap. 232. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE GRANTING OF LICENSES FOR THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES BY VETERANS' ORGANIZATIONS IN THE TOWN OF DOVER.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Notwithstanding any limitation imposed by section eleven A of chapter one hundred and thirty-eight of the General Laws as to the time and manner of voting upon the questions therein set forth, and to section seventeen of said chapter as to the number thereof, the state secretary shall cause to be placed on the official ballot to be used in the town of Dover at the biennial state election to be held in the year nineteen hundred and eighty-four the following question: -

"Shall licenses be granted in the town of Dover for the sale therein of all alcoholic beverages by war veterans' organizations?"

If a majority of the votes cast in said town in answer to said question is in the affirmative, said town shall be taken to have authorized the sale in said town of all alcoholic beverages to be drunk on the premises of veterans' organizations as defined and limited in section twelve of said chapter one hundred and thirty-eight, notwithstanding any provisions of said section twelve to the contrary.

Said licenses shall be subject, however, to all other provisions of said chapter one hundred and thirty-eight.
