AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE REVOCATION AND SUSPENSION OF MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATIONS AND LICENSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section twenty-two of chapter ninety of the Gen-
2 eral Laws, as amended by chapter one hundred and
3 ninety-one of the acts of nineteen hundred and thirty-
4 three, is hereby further amended by adding at the end
5 thereof the following new paragraph: —

6 Notice of the revocation or suspension of any certifi-
7 cate of registration or any license under this section
8 shall be given by the registrar to the holder of such
9 certificate or license, and such notice shall specify the
10 particular reasons for such revocation or suspension
11 and shall state the time and place of the alleged viola-
12 tion or the incident upon which the revocation or sus-
13 pension was based and shall also state the name and
14 address of the police officer or other person who made
15 the complaint.
