RESOLUTIONS MEMORIALIZING CONGRESS TO PROPOSE AN AMENDMENT TO THE UNITED STATES CONSTITUTION PROVIDING FOR THE DIRECT AND POPULAR ELECTION OF PRESIDENT AND VICE-PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES.

1 *Resolved*, That the General Court of Massachu-
2 setts hereby respectfully requests the Congress of
3 the United States to propose an amendment to the
4 Constitution of the United States providing for the
5 direct and popular election of President and Vice-
6 President of the United States; and be it further

7 *Resolved*, That copies of these resolutions be for-
8 warded by the Secretary of the Commonwealth to the
9 presiding officer of each branch of the Congress of the
10 United States and to the members thereof from this
11 Commonwealth.
