AN ACT TO CONTINUE A SPECIAL ACT IN REGARD TO CERTAIN ELECTION LAWS IN THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The law to hold a primary in June be continued
2 for the year nineteen hundred and forty-six so that
3 those still in the service at that time shall have the
4 privilege of voting in a primary in nineteen hundred
5 and forty-six.
