AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE BORROWING OF MONEY BY THE TOWN OF PLYMOUTH FOR THE PURPOSE OF REMODELING THE OLD HIGH SCHOOL BUILDING AND INSTALLING A NEW HEATING PLANT AND VENTILATING SYSTEM THEREIN, ERECTING A BUILDING ADJACENT TO SAID HIGH SCHOOL BUILDING AND PURCHASING EQUIPMENT FOR A VOCATIONAL SCHOOL.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section one of chapter one hundred  
2 and sixty-one of the acts of nineteen hundred and  
3 forty-one is hereby amended by striking out, in the  
4 sixth line, the word "five" and inserting in place  
5 thereof the word:— ten, — and by striking out, in  
6 the eighth line, the word "fifty" and inserting in  
7 place thereof the word:— seventy-five, — so as to  
8 read as follows:— *Section 1.* For the purposes of  
9 remodeling the old high school building and installing  
10 a new heating plant and ventilating system therein,

11 and of erecting a building adjacent to said high school  
12 building, and for the purchase of equipment for a  
13 vocational school, the town of Plymouth may borrow,  
14 from time to time, within a period of ten years from  
15 the passage of this act, such sums as may be neces-  
16 sary, not exceeding, in the aggregate, seventy-five  
17 thousand dollars, and may issue bonds or notes  
18 therefor, which shall bear on the face the words,  
19 Plymouth School Loan, Act of 1941. Each author-  
20 ized issue shall constitute a separate loan, and such  
21 loans shall be paid in not more than ten years from  
22 their dates. Indebtedness incurred under this act  
23 shall be within the statutory limitation, but shall,  
24 except as provided herein, be subject to chapter forty-  
25 four of the General Laws, inclusive of the limitation  
26 contained in the first paragraph of section seven  
27 thereof.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
