AN ACT REQUIRING PAYMENT BY EMPLOYERS FOR MEDICAL EXAMINATIONS OF EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 149 of the General Laws, as amended, is
2 hereby further amended by the addition after section
3 159A of the following new section: —
4 *Section 159B.* Any employer who requests or
5 requires a person who is a present or prospective
6 employee to undergo a medical examination, as a
7 condition to securing or continuing in employment,
8 shall reimburse said person for any expenses incurred
9 by him in connection with said examination, including
10 all medical charges.
