AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE OBSERVANCE OF LEGAL HOLIDAYS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Every legal holiday shall be observed on the Mon-
2 day of the week in which it falls, and its observance or
3 celebration on that day shall so far as possible be
4 identical with the observance or celebration which
5 would otherwise be held. Notwithstanding the provi-
6 sions of this act, the name of every legal holiday shall
7 remain unchanged.
