

HOUSE No. 1293

By Messrs. Bagley of Townsend and Telford of Plainville, petition of Earle S. Bagley and Clarence F. Telford that certain employees of the Departments of Mental Health and Public Welfare be included in the provisions of Group B in the retirement law. Pensions and Old Age Assistance.

AN ACT TO INCLUDE UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF GROUP B IN THE RETIREMENT LAW CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE DEPARTMENTS OF MENTAL HEALTH AND PUBLIC WELFARE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Subsection (2) (g) of section 3 of chapter 32 of the
2 General Laws, as most recently amended by section 1
3 of chapter 423 of the acts of 1947, is hereby further
4 amended by striking out the paragraph entitled
5 "Group B" and inserting in place thereof the follow-
6 ing paragraph:—
7 *Group B.*—Members of police and fire departments
8 not classified in Group A, members of the police force
9 of the metropolitan district commission, capitol
10 police, conservation officers paid as such, district fire
11 wardens, coastal wardens in the department of con-
12 servation, officials and employees of the registry of

13 motor vehicles having police powers, and employees
14 of the commonwealth and of any county, regardless of
15 any official classification, whose regular and major
16 duties require them to have the care and custody of
17 prisoners, or defective delinquents, or insane, feeble-
18 minded or epileptic persons, or inmates of the Massa-
19 chusetts training schools under the supervision of the
20 department of public welfare.
