By Mr. Jordan of Revere, petition of Edmund R. Dewing and others for legislation relative to the granting of the degree of bachelor of science in pharmacy by the Boston School of Pharmacy. Education.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Eight.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE GRANTING OF THE DEGREE OF BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN PHARMACY BY THE TRUSTEES OF THE BOSTON SCHOOL OF PHARMACY.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would
2 prevent the exercise of the degree granting power
3 of the corporation referred to therein in the case of
4 its graduating class in the current year, therefore it
5 is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary
6 for the immediate preservation of the public con-
7 venience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 571 of the acts of 1943 is hereby amended
2 by striking out, in lines 6 and 7, the words "estab-
3 lished by chapter five hundred and forty-nine of the
4 acts of nineteen hundred and forty-three" and in-
5 serting in place thereof the words:— existing under
6 authority of section three A of chapter fifteen of the

7 General Laws, as most recently amended by section
8 three of chapter six hundred and fifty-two of the
9 acts of nineteen hundred and forty-seven, — so as
10 to read as follows:—The trustees of The Boston
11 School of Pharmacy, a corporation organized under
12 chapter one hundred and eighty of the General Laws,
13 are hereby authorized to confer the degree of Bachelor
14 of Science in Pharmacy, if and when said school
15 complies with the requirements of the board of col-
16 legiate authority existing under authority of section
17 three A of chapter fifteen of the General Laws, as
18 most recently amended by section three of chapter
19 six hundred and fifty-two of the acts of nineteen
20 hundred and forty-seven.
