### AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE OFFICE OF THIRD ASSISTANT CLERK IN THE DISTRICT COURT OF SPRINGFIELD.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The second paragraph of section 10 of  
2 chapter 218 of the General Laws, as amended, is  
3 hereby further amended by inserting after the word  
4 "Middlesex" in line 5, the words: — the district court  
5 of Springfield, — so as to read as follows: — Third  
6 assistant clerks with salaries payable by the county  
7 may be appointed in the municipal court of Roxbury  
8 district, and, subject to the approval of the county  
9 commissioners, in the first district court of eastern  
10 Middlesex, the third district court of eastern Middle-  
11 sex, the district court of Springfield and the district  
12 court of East Norfolk.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take full effect upon its  
2 acceptance during the current year by vote of the  
3 county commissioners of the county of Hampden, but  
4 not otherwise.
