## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT RELATIVE TO PAYMENTS BY THE COMMONWEALTH  
IN REIMBURSEMENT FOR THE COST OF CERTAIN SHORE  
PROTECTIVE WORK IN THE TOWN OF FALMOUTH AND  
COUNTY OF BARNSTABLE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 500 of the acts of 1947 is hereby amended  
2 by striking out the words "eighty thousand" and in-  
3 serting in substitution therefor the words eighty-three  
4 hundred, — and it shall be further amended by strik-  
5 ing out the words "July twenty-fifth" and inserting  
6 in substitution therefor: — September fifteenth, — so  
7 that the said chapter will read as follows: — Notwith-  
8 standing any provision of law to the contrary, the  
9 amount of reimbursements to be paid by the common-  
10 wealth under chapter seven hundred and thirty-four  
11 of the acts of nineteen hundred and forty-five shall  
12 not exceed eighty thousand three hundred dollars, and  
13 such reimbursements shall be restricted to the work

14 of building structures to protect the coast line from  
15 damage by the sea, which work was undertaken or  
16 contracted for after September fourteenth, nineteen  
17 hundred and forty-four and prior to September fif-  
18 teenth nineteen hundred forty-five and was completed  
19 prior to December thirty-first, nineteen hundred and  
20 forty-six.
