AN ACT PROVIDING THAT EMPLOYERS SHALL PAY TO THEIR EMPLOYEES WHO ARE MEMBERS OF MILITARY UNITS OF THE COMMONWEALTH REGULAR COMPENSATION FOR A PERIOD NOT EXCEEDING TWO WEEKS FOR REQUIRED MILITARY TRAINING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

5 weekly compensation for such period which they
6 would have been entitled to receive in their regular
7 employment for a period not exceeding two weeks.
