
By Mr. Smith of Easthampton, petition of J. Sydney Croke, Fletcher Smith, Jr., and others for legislation to authorize Fire District No. 2 in South Hadley to borrow money for water purposes. Municipal Finance.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING FIRE DISTRICT NO. 2 IN SOUTH HADLEY TO BORROW MONEY FOR WATER PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Fire District No. 2 in South Hadley,
2 for the purpose of paying the necessary expenses for
3 improving its water supply system and in order to
4 improve the adequacy and reliability of water service
5 for fire protection and for domestic use, and more par-
6 ticularly but without limiting the generality of the
7 foregoing, for the following additions, extensions and
8 improvements to the existing water supply system,
9 including acquisition of lands and easements in con-
10 nection therewith: (1) Prospect hill standpipe, in-
11 cluding foundation, drain and twelve-inch connection
12 to the existing Park street six-inch pipe; (2) Park
13 street twelve-inch pipe from College street to connect
14 with standpipe; (3) force main from pumping station
15 to existing standpipes. Force main to be eight-inch
16 from pumping station to Moody corner and then ten-
17 inch to standpipe; (4) additions and alterations to
18 main pumping station, including new pumps, motors,
19 automatic controls, chlorinator and all related piping
20 and electrical work; (5) Lythia Springs pipeline from
21 existing reservoir to end of existing pipeline at Elmer

22 brook pumping station; proposed pipe to be eight-
23 inch; (6) Mosier street eight-inch main forty-five
24 hundred feet to connect with existing main on Col-
25 lege street; (7) new filter bed, may borrow from time
26 to time within five years from the passage of this
27 act such sums of money as may be necessary, not ex-
28 ceeding in the aggregate, two hundred and twenty-five
29 thousand dollars, and may issue bonds or notes of
30 the district which shall bear on their face the words,
31 Fire District No. 2 in South Hadley Water Loan,
32 Act of 1954. Each authorized issue shall constitute
33 a separate loan, and such loans shall be paid in not
34 more than twenty years from their dates. Indebted-
35 ness incurred under this act shall be within the
36 statutory limit of indebtedness for districts au-
37 thorized by chapter forty-four of the General Laws,
38 and, except as otherwise provided by this act, shall
39 be subject to the applicable provisions of said chapter.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
