Ordered, That the committee on metropolitan affairs is hereby authorized to sit during the recess of the general court for the purpose of making an investigation and study relative to the subject matter of current senate document numbered 63 relating to the making of contracts by the Metropolitan Transit Authority. Said committee shall be provided with quarters in the state house, may travel within the commonwealth, and may expend for expenses and for clerical and other assistance such sums as may be appropriated therefor. Said committee shall report to the general court the results of its investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the clerk of the house of representatives on or before the first Wednesday of December in the current year.
