### AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE AMOUNT OF CERTAIN ALLOWANCES UNDER THE RETIREMENT ACT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Subdivision 2 (f) of section 5 of chapter 32 of the Gen-  
2 eral Laws is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof  
3 the following: — nor shall the total normal yearly amount  
4 of the retirement allowance of any member, as deter-  
5 mined in accordance with the provisions of this section,  
6 for a member who has had less than ten years of mem-  
7 bership service, exceed fifty per cent of the amount of  
8 his accumulated regular deductions.
