AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE TENURE OF OFFICE OF THE HIGHWAY SUPERINTENDENT IN THE TOWN OF NEW BRAINTREE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The tenure of office of the present incumbent
2 of the office of highway superintendent in the town of New
3 Braintree shall be unlimited during good behavior.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take full effect upon its ac-
2 ceptance by a majority of the voters voting thereon at a
3 regular or special town meeting.
