AN ACT TO INCREASE THE BENEFIT DURATION PERIOD OF THE MASSACHUSETTS EMPLOYMENT SECURITY ACT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 30 of chapter 151A of the General Laws, is hereby
- 2 amended by striking out said section, as most recently amended
- 3 and inserting in place thereof the following section:—
- 4 *Section 30.* The total benefits which an unemployed indi-
- 5 vidual may receive during his benefit year shall be an amount
- 6 equal to forty per cent of his wages in the base period, or an
- 7 amount equal to thirty-nine times his benefit rate, whichever
- 8 is the lesser, plus dependency benefits payable under section
- 9 twenty-nine. If such amount includes a fractional part of a
- 10 dollar, it shall be raised to the next highest dollar.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Conference assembled, That

Section 1.
