

SENATE No. 17

To accompany the petition of Gaspar G. Bacon for legislation relative to the construction of certain parts of Centre Street in the city of Boston. Municipal Finance.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-One.

An Act changing the Width to which Certain Parts of Centre Street in the City of Boston shall be Reconstructed.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section one of chapter two hundred
2 and forty-eight of the acts of nineteen hundred and
3 twenty-nine is hereby amended by striking out, in
4 the fourth, fifth and sixth lines, the words "to a
5 point at or near Weld street, to a width of not less
6 than one hundred feet, and, from said last mentioned
7 point," — and by striking out in the seventh line, the
8 word "less" and inserting in place thereof the
9 word: — more, — so as to read as follows: — *Section*
10 1. The board of street commissioners of the city of
11 Boston may, with the approval of the mayor of said
12 city, lay out, widen, extend, relocate and reconstruct
13 Centre street in said city from a point at or near
14 May street to a point at or near South street, to
15 width of not more than eighty feet.

16 After such construction, said Centre street so recon-
17 structed from a point at or near said May street to
18 a point at or near said South street shall be under
19 the charge of the board of park commissioners of
20 said city as a parkway, and said last mentioned board
21 shall have the charge and control of such parkway
22 as if the same had been placed in its charge under
23 section four of chapter forty-five of the General
24 Laws.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 acceptance during the current year by vote of the
3 city council of said city, subject to the provisions of
4 its charter, but not otherwise.
