

SENATE No. 371

To accompany the petition of Albert Cole that provision be made for the acquisition by the Commonwealth for armory purposes of certain land in the city of Lynn owned by the Lynn Boys' Club. Military Affairs.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Six.

An Act providing for the Acquisition by the Commonwealth for Armory Purposes of Certain Land in the City of Lynn owned by the Lynn Boys' Club.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 After an appropriation has been made, and
2 subject to the approval of the governor and
3 council, the armory commissioners are hereby
4 authorized and directed to acquire, for the pur-
5 pose of increasing the facilities of the state ar-
6 mory in said city the following described parcel
7 of land: bounded northeasterly by Pleasant
8 street, eighty-two feet, southeasterly by land of
9 Valeri, one hundred and thirty-five and eighty
10 one hundredths feet, southwesterly by land of
11 Maheras, thirty and sixty-two one hundredths

12 feet; again southeasterly by land of Maheras,
13 twenty-six and sixty-two one hundredths feet;
14 again southwesterly, by land of Magrave, thirty-
15 one and eighty-five one hundredths feet; again
16 southeasterly, by land of Magrave, three and
17 seventy-one one hundredths feet, to land of
18 Pearce and the state of Massachusetts; again
19 southwesterly by land of the state of Massachu-
20 setts, twenty-three and nine one hundredths feet;
21 northwesterly by land of the Phelan estate, one
22 hundred and fifty-one and sixty-eight hundredths
23 feet, to Pleasant street, containing approximately
24 twelve thousand four hundred and forty square
25 feet.
