RESOLUTIONS MEMORIALIZING CONGRESS IN FAVOR OF THE
PRESENTATION TO EIRE OF A STATUE OF COMMODORE
JOHN BARRY, "THE FATHER OF THE UNITED STATES
NAVY".

1 *Whereas*, There is pending in the Congress of the
2 United States a bill providing for the presentation to
3 Eire of a statue of Commodore John Barry, known
4 as "The Father of the United States Navy"; there-
5 fore be it

6 *Resolved*, That the Senate of the Commonwealth
7 of Massachusetts records itself in favor of said bill
8 and respectfully urges the Congress of the United
9 States to enact the same into law; and be it further

10 *Resolved*, That the Secretary of the Common-
11 wealth send engrossed copies of these resolutions to
12 the presiding officers of both branches of the Con-
13 gress and to each member thereof from this Com-
14 monwealth.
