AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE METROPOLITAN TRANSIT AUTHORITY TO EXTEND ITS RAPID TRANSIT FACILITIES TO NORTH CAMBRIDGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The trustees of the Metropolitan
2 Transit Authority, hereinafter referred to as the
3 Authority, are hereby authorized and directed to
4 construct and maintain an extension of rapid transit
5 facilities in Cambridge in a northerly and westerly
6 direction from the present terminal in Harvard square
7 to the Arlington town line, and may acquire by pur-
8 chase or eminent domain any public or private lands
9 necessary for the purposes of this act.

1 SECTION 2. For the purposes of providing funds
2 for, or of restoring to the treasury of the Authority
3 funds expended for, the purposes of this act, the
4 Authority shall from time to time issue, and the

5 Boston metropolitan district, hereinafter referred
6 to as the district, shall purchase bonds of the Au-
7 thority to a total principal amount of not exceeding
8 dollars under and in accordance with
9 section six of chapter six hundred and forty-nine
10 of the acts of nineteen hundred and forty-nine, as
11 amended. All of the provisions of said section six
12 and of section seven of said chapter six hundred and
13 forty-nine, as now or hereafter amended, shall apply
14 to the issue, refunding and payment of the bonds
15 which the Authority and the district are authorized
16 to issue by this act in the same manner and to the
17 same extent as though the issue of such bonds was
18 specifically authorized by said section six.
