AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE CONSTRUCTION OF AN OVERPASS CONNECTING SOLDIERS' FIELD ROAD WITH COMMONWEALTH AVENUE, BOSTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The metropolitan district commission is hereby au-
2 thorized to construct an overpass west of Cottage
3 Farm bridge to connect traffic from Soldiers' Field
4 road with Commonwealth avenue in the city of Boston.
5 For the purpose of this act the commission is author-
6 ized to take any lands or easements thereon of the
7 Boston and Albany Railroad, or any department of
8 the state of Massachusetts, the city of Boston, or
9 any private owners. The commission is authorized
10 to spend such sums for the construction, maintenance
11 and takings of land or easements as may be appro-
12 priated therefor. Said appropriations shall be from
13 the Highway Fund.
