AN ACT INCREASING THE SALARIES OF THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF STATE EXAMINERS OF PLUMBERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 13 of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 by striking out section 38, as appearing in the Ter-
3 centenary Edition, and inserting in place thereof the
4 following:—

5 *Section 38.* There shall be paid by the common-
6 wealth to the chairman of the examiners a salary of
7 one thousand dollars and to each other member thereof
8 a salary of eight hundred dollars, and to each member
9 thereof his necessary traveling expenses actually in-
10 curred in attending meetings of the examiners. The
11 division of registration shall furnish the examiners
12 with such clerical assistance as may be necessary.
