RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE DISPOSAL OF SOLID WASTES IN THE GREATER BOSTON AREA.

1 *Resolved*, That an unpaid special commission, to consist of
2 three members of the senate, five members of the house of
3 representatives, the commissioners of public health, the metro-
4 politan district and the department of commerce, or their re-
5 spective designees, and five persons to be appointed by the gov-
6 ernor, at least two of whom shall be registered professional en-
7 gineers, is hereby established for the purpose of making an in-
8 vestigation and study relative to the disposal of solid wastes
9 in the greater Boston area. Said commission may travel with-
10 in and without the commonwealth, may require by summons
11 the attendance and testimony of witnesses and the production
12 of books and papers, and may expend, in addition to such sums
13 as may be appropriated therefor such other funds as may be
14 made available to the commission through grants or gifts from
15 private or public sources.
