Kelly, Jr., for legislation to authorize the county commissioners of Worcester County to borrow money to acquire land in the town of Westborough and to construct thereon and originally equip a new courthouse building for the First District Court of Eastern Worcester. Counties.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WORCESTER COUNTY TO BORROW MONEY TO ACQUIRE LAND IN THE TOWN OF WESTBOROUGH AND TO CONSTRUCT THEREON AND ORIGINALLY EQUIP A NEW COURTHOUSE BUILDING FOR THE FIRST DISTRICT COURT OF EASTERN WORCESTER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The county commissioners of Worcester County
2 are hereby authorized to acquire land in the town of West-
3 borough and to construct thereon and originally equip a new
4 courthouse building for the first district court of eastern
5 Worcester.

1 SECTION 2. For the purpose aforesaid the treasurer of said
2 county, with the approval of the county commissioners, may
3 borrow upon the credit of the county such sums as may be
4 necessary, not exceeding, in the aggregate, five hundred thou-
5 sand dollars, and may issue bonds or notes of the county there-
6 for which shall bear on their face the words First District
7 Court of Eastern Worcester Court House Loan, Act of 1966.
8 Each authorized issue shall constitute a separate loan, and
9 such loans shall be payable in not more than twenty years from
10 their dates. The bonds or notes shall be signed by the county
11 treasurer and countersigned by a majority of the county com-
12 missioners. The county may sell the said securities at public
13 or private sale, upon such terms and conditions as the county

14 commissioners may deem proper, but not for less than their
15 par value. Indebtedness incurred hereunder shall, except as
16 herein provided, be subject to chapter thirty-five of the Gen-
17 eral Laws. The county treasurer, with the approval of the
18 county commissioners, may issue temporary notes of the
19 county, payable in not more than one year from their date,
20 in anticipation of the issue of serial bonds or notes under this
21 act, but the time within which such serial bonds or notes shall
22 become due and payable shall not, by reason of such temporary
23 notes, be extended beyond the time fixed by this act. Any
24 notes issued in anticipation of the serial bonds or notes shall
25 be paid from the proceeds thereof.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
