#### AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF WEYMOUTH TO BORROW MONEY FOR ENLARGING, ALTERING AND IMPROVING ITS WATER FILTRATION PLANT, PUMPING STATION, AND INTAKE AT GREAT POND, AND FOR RELATED FACILITIES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. For the purposes of enlarging, altering and im-  
2 proving its water filtration plant, pumping station and intake  
3 at Great Pond, and related facilities, the town of Weymouth  
4 may borrow from time to time such sums of money as may  
5 be necessary, not exceeding in the aggregate seven hundred  
6 fifty thousand dollars and may issue bonds or notes therefor.  
7 Each authorized issue shall constitute a separate loan and such  
8 loans shall be payable in not more than twenty years from  
9 their dates. Indebtedness incurred under this act shall be in  
10 excess of the statutory limits provided by sections eight and  
11 ten of chapter forty-four of the General Laws and shall, except  
12 as provided herein, be subject to the provisions of said chapter  
13 forty-four.

1 SECTION 2. Any action taken in the current year by any  
2 town meeting in the town of Weymouth to authorize borrow-  
3 ing for the purposes mentioned in section one of this act is  
4 hereby confirmed and validated to the same extent as though  
5 this act had been in effect at the time of the posting of the  
6 warrant for such meeting.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
