AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF AN ADDITIONAL ASSISTANT DISTRICT ATTORNEY FOR THE PLYMOUTH DISTRICT AND ESTABLISHING HIS SALARY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 14 of chapter 12 of the General Laws,
2 as most recently amended by section 1 of chapter 662 of the
3 acts of 1966, is hereby further amended by striking out the
4 seventh paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following
5 paragraph: —

6 For the Plymouth district, five assistant district attorneys.

1 SECTION 2. Section 16 of said chapter 12 is hereby amended
2 by striking out the seventh paragraph and inserting in place
3 thereof the following paragraph: —

4 For the Plymouth district, one assistant, nine thousand five
5 hundred dollars; one assistant, eight thousand five hundred
6 dollars; one assistant, seven thousand five hundred dollars; and
7 two assistants, six thousand five hundred dollars.
