## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Two.

### AN ACT

To authorize the Conveyance of Certain Land of the Commonwealth in Waltham, Lexington and Belmont.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The commissioner on mental diseases is hereby  
2 authorized, subject to the approval of the gov-  
3 ernor and council, to execute, acknowledge and  
4 deliver in the name and behalf of the common-  
5 wealth to Joseph English of Lexington, his heirs  
6 and assigns, such deeds as may be necessary to  
7 convey a parcel of land situated in Waltham,  
8 Lexington and Belmont, bounded and described  
9 as follows:—Commencing at the most westerly  
10 corner of said parcel at the intersection of two

11 ditches; thence by a ditch and thence a stone  
12 wall and land now or formerly of Shea north  
13 thirty-one degrees, four minutes, fifty seconds  
14 east five hundred six and three tenths feet; thence  
15 by a stone wall and land now or formerly of said  
16 English and Vincent north eighty-nine degrees,  
17 fifty-three minutes east four hundred thirty-six  
18 and three tenths feet; thence across the end of a  
19 right of way and along stone walls and by said  
20 land of English and Vincent as follows:—south,  
21 one degree, twenty-six minutes, fifty seconds,  
22 west three hundred eighty-two and five tenths  
23 feet; thence north eighty-five degrees, two sec-  
24 onds west two hundred twenty and two tenths  
25 feet; thence north seventy-two degrees, fifty-one  
26 minutes, thirty seconds west one hundred sixty-  
27 seven and one tenth feet; thence south thirty-  
28 nine degrees, fifty-one seconds west two hundred  
29 eighty-two and five tenths feet to a ditch; thence  
30 by said ditch and land now or formerly of Wright  
31 north fifty-two degrees, fifty-nine minutes, thirty  
32 seconds west one hundred sixty and two-tenths  
33 feet to point of beginning, being all measurements  
34 more or less and said parcel containing five and  
35 two-hundredths acres more or less.
