## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Eight.

An Act relative to Fees for Members of the Police Force of the Metropolitan District Commission in Certain Cases and to the Service of Subpoenas by them.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section fifty-three of chapter two hundred and  
2 sixty-two of the General Laws, as amended by section  
3 one of chapter three hundred and seventy-seven of the  
4 acts of nineteen hundred and twenty-two, is hereby  
5 further amended by adding at the end thereof the  
6 following new sentence: — The words "police officer",  
7 as used in this section, shall include a member of the  
8 police force of the metropolitan district commission.
