## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-One.

---

An Act authorizing the City of Boston to pay an Annuity to the Widow of Frank L. Lyons, a Former Captain in the Fire Department of Said City.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The city of Boston may pay to  
2 Catherine A. Lyons, widow of Frank L. Lyons,  
3 a former captain in the fire department of said  
4 city, who died from injuries received and illness  
5 contracted in the performance of his duty after  
6 thirty years of service in said department, an  
7 annuity of one thousand dollars payable in  
8 monthly installments, the same to continue as  
9 long as she remains unmarried.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon  
2 its acceptance during the current year by vote  
3 of the city council of said city, subject to the  
4 provisions of its charter, but not otherwise.
