By Mr. Crowley of Somerville, petition of John J. Crowley that right of way of fire apparatus, patrol wagons and ambulances be restricted. Highways and Motor Vehicles.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Four.

An Act restricting the Right of Way of Fire Apparatus,
Patrol Wagons and Ambulances.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section seven of chapter eighty-nine of the
2 General Laws, as appearing in the Tercentenary
3 edition thereof, is hereby amended by inserting
4 after the word "alley", in the fourth line, the
5 words: —, except at any intersection of ways
6 when the driver of such apparatus, wagon or
7 ambulance is otherwise directed by a police officer,
8 or by a lawful traffic regulating sign, device or
9 signal maintained by or with the approval of the
10 department of public works and while such ap-
11 proval is in effect, or otherwise lawfully maintained.
