

SENATE No. 472

To accompany the petition of Frederick A. Leavitt and others, county commissioners of Norfolk County, that they be authorized to build and equip a nurses' home at the Norfolk County Hospital, Counties.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Five.

An Act authorizing the County Commissioners of Norfolk County to Build and Equip a Nurses' Home at the Norfolk County Hospital.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The Norfolk county commissioners are
2 hereby authorized to raise and expend a sum not
3 exceeding one hundred thousand dollars, subject to
4 the provisions of sections seventy-eight to ninety, in-
5 clusive, of chapter one hundred and eleven of the
6 General Laws, for the purpose of building and equip-
7 ping a nurses' home at the Norfolk county sanatorium,
8 a hospital for the treatment of persons afflicted with
9 tuberculosis, in the town of Braintree.

1 SECTION 2. The provisions of chapter three hun-
2 dred and sixty-six of the acts of nineteen hundred and
3 thirty-three, whereby cities and towns, or fire, water,
4 light or improvement districts may secure the bene-

5 fits provided by the National Industrial Recovery
6 Act, shall apply to the work contemplated by this
7 act, and the Norfolk county commissioners shall, with
8 the consent of the governor of the commonwealth, be
9 authorized to take any and all steps necessary from
10 time to time to enable the county of Norfolk to secure
11 any benefits to which said county may be entitled
12 under the National Recovery Act.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its ac-
2 ceptance during the current year by the county
3 commissioners.
