

HOUSE No. 121

By Mr. Sullivan of Boston, petition of Katherine G. Bresnahan that she be made eligible to receive certain allowances under the law providing for retirement of employees of the city of Boston and county of Suffolk. Pensions.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Six.

An Act making Katherine G. Bresnahan eligible to receive upon Retirement Certain Allowances under the Boston Retirement Act.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The Boston retirement board, estab-
2 lished under chapter five hundred and twenty-one of
3 the acts of nineteen hundred and twenty-two, as
4 amended, in computing the retirement allowance to be
5 paid under the provisions of said act to Katherine G.
6 Bresnahan, formerly employed by the commonwealth
7 as a clerk in the registry of motor vehicles, and now
8 employed by the city of Boston as a clerk in the supply
9 department of said city, upon her retirement, shall
10 compute said allowance upon the total of her periods of
11 service in the employ of the commonwealth and of said
12 city, and any provision of said chapter five hundred
13 and twenty-one, as amended, inconsistent herewith
14 shall not apply to her. There shall be paid forthwith

15 by said Katherine G. Bresnahan to said Boston retire-
16 ment board the sum of six hundred and ninety-one
17 dollars and thirty-two cents received by her from the
18 state board of retirement, together with interest equal
19 to that which would have been earned by said sum
20 from the date of her leaving the service of the state
21 and entering that of the city of Boston, said sum to be
22 computed by said Boston retirement board; and upon
23 such retirement there shall be paid by the common-
24 wealth to the Boston retirement board a sum to be
25 computed by said board which shall be equal to the
26 contribution which the city of Boston is then required
27 to make to the retirement reserve fund on account
28 of that portion of the services of said Katherine G.
29 Bresnahan rendered to the commonwealth.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
