AN ACT PROVIDING FOR BI-PARTISAN BOARDS OF REGISTRARS OF VOTERS IN ALL CITIES AND TOWNS IN THE COMMONWEALTH.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter fifty-one of the General Laws is hereby amended  
2 by striking out section sixteen and all amendments thereto.
