To accompany the petition of James M. Curley relative to the registration of voters in the city of Boston. Election Laws.

AN ACT

Relative to Registration of Voters in Boston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section eighty-three of chapter eight hundred
2 and thirty-five of the acts of the year nineteen hun-
3 dred and thirteen is hereby amended by striking
4 out the words "the same number of like," in the
5 seventh and eighth lines of said section, and insert-
6 ing in place thereof the words:— not less than five
7 such evening,— so as to read as follows:— *Sec-*
8 *tion 83.* Said board shall hold such day sessions
9 as the city may by ordinance prescribe, and such
10 additional sessions as they shall deem necessary.
11 They shall, in any event, hold in or near each ward
12 in said city not less than ten evening sessions, each
13 of at least three hours' duration, between the first
