## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifteen.

### AN ACT

To authorize the Massachusetts Highway Commission to improve a Highway in the Town of Ware.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The Massachusetts highway commis-  
2 sion is hereby authorized to expend a sum not ex-  
3 ceeding ten thousand dollars during the present year  
4 in the construction and improvement of the highway  
5 in the town of Ware, known as the Palmer road, ex-  
6 tending from Three Mile bridge, so called, in Ware  
7 to the Palmer line.

1 SECTION 2. The cost and expense incurred under  
2 the provision of this act shall be borne as follows :—  
3 the county of Hampshire shall pay twenty-five per  
4 cent, the town of Ware twenty-five per cent and the  
5 commonwealth shall pay fifty per cent.

1 SECTION 3. For the purpose of meeting this ex-  
2 pense the county of Hampshire is authorized to bor-  
3 row upon the credit of the county such sums as shall  
4 be necessary to pay its share, the town of Ware is  
5 authorized to issue the notes and bonds of the town  
6 therefor — such notes and bonds shall bear interest  
7 at a rate not exceeding four and one half per cent,  
8 and the treasurer of the commonwealth shall issue  
9 bonds for \$5,000 under such conditions as shall meet  
10 the approval of the governor and his council.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
