**AN ACT**

To provide for One Day's Rest in Seven for Employees of Hotels and Restaurants.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section five of chapter six hundred and nine-  
2 teen of the acts of the year nineteen hundred  
3 and thirteen is hereby amended by striking  
4 out the words "hotels and restaurants", in  
5 the seventh line, — so as to read as follows:—  
6 *Section 5.* In this act "manufacturing estab-  
7 lishments" and "mercantile establishments" shall  
8 have the meaning defined in section seventeen  
9 of chapter five hundred and fourteen of the  
10 acts of the year nineteen hundred and nine,  
11 except that neither of said terms shall be held  
12 to include establishments used for the manu-  
13 facture of or distribution of gas, electricity,  
14 milk or water, drug stores, livery stables, or  
15 garages.
