*To the Honorable Senate and House of Representatives:*

In accordance with the provisions of Article LVI of the Amendments of the Constitution, I am returning herewith House, No. 1825 entitled "An Act designating a Portion of New Route 25 in the Town of Middleborough as Massachusetts State Guard Veterans Highway".

I am recommending that the bill be amended by striking out the word "east" as it appears in line two of the engrossed bill and substituting therefor the word "south".

This amendment is necessary because an investigation by the Department of Public Works indicates that the correct compass direction from the Middleborough traffic circle is south.
