## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

### AN ACT DESIGNATING THE UNION STREET PLAYGROUND IN THE BRIGHTON DISTRICT OF THE CITY OF BOSTON AS THE WILLIAM F. JOYCE PLAYGROUND.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The recreational area located in the Brighton  
2 district of the city of Boston, and now known and referred to  
3 as the Union street playground shall hereafter be designated  
4 by the park department of the city of Boston as the William F.  
5 Joyce playground, in memory of William F. Joyce, who served  
6 as a member of the house of representatives, and that a suitable  
7 marker bearing said designation be erected and maintained at  
8 said area by said department.

2 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
