AN ACT VALIDATING THE DIVISION OF CERTAIN TOWNS FOR CENSUS AND REDISTRICTING PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of chapter 54
2 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by chapter 735
3 of the acts of 1972, any change made by any city in its plan of
4 wards and voting precincts and any change made by any town in
5 its voting precincts after the thirty-first day of July in the year
6 nineteen hundred and seventy-one and prior to the thirty-first
7 day of December in the year nineteen hundred and seventy-two,
8 such change being the basis upon which census figures are
9 returned under oath to the office of the secretary, shall become
10 effective forthwith for purposes of reporting the census and
11 dividing the commonwealth into two hundred and forty repre-
12 sentative, forty senatorial and eight councillor districts under the
13 provisions of Article XCII of the Amendments of the Constitu-
14 tion.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
