By Mr. Viveiros of Fall River, petition of Carlton M. Viveiros that motor vehicles owned and registered to certain handicapped persons be exempt from the motor vehicle excise tax law. Taxation.

AN ACT EXEMPTING MOTOR VEHICLES OWNED AND REGISTERED TO CERTAIN HANDICAPPED PERSONS FROM THE MOTOR VEHICLE EXCISE TAX.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The fifth paragraph of section 1 of chapter 60A, as most
2 recently amended by chapter 117 of the acts of 1967, is
3 hereby further amended by adding the following sen-
4 tence: — The excise imposed by this section shall not apply to
5 a blind or disabled person whose motor vehicle bears the
6 distinctive type plate authorized under section two of chapter
7 ninety.
