AN ACT AMENDING THE LAWS RELATIVE TO THE APPOINTMENT OF JUVENILE COURT OFFICIALS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 58 of Chapter 218 of the General Laws as most re-
2 cently amended by Chapter 731 of the Acts of 1972, is hereby
3 further amended by inserting in the first sentence of paragraph
4 one Section 58 after the words "a member of the bar" the words
5 "or a person who shall be qualified by education, training and
6 professional experience in working with juveniles,"; and is fur-
7 ther amended by inserting at the end of sentence one paragraph
8 one, section 58 the following: —

9 " , or other professional occupation which provides his qualifi-
10 cations."
