By Mrs. Gray of Framingham, petition of Barbara E. Gray and Robert J. Bohigian relative to the display of number plates on motor vehicles. Public Safety.

AN ACT RELATING TO THE DISPLAY OF NUMBER PLATES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 6 of Chapter 90 of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by striking out the first sentence of said section
3 and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:—

4 Every motor vehicle or trailer registered under this chapter
5 when operated in or on any way in this commonwealth shall have
6 its register number displayed conspicuously thereon by the
7 number plate furnished by the registrar in accordance with
8 section two or five or by a temporary number plate authorized by
9 the registrar as hereinafter provided, the number plate to be
10 attached at the rear of said motor vehicle, and one number plate
11 to be attached at the rear of said motor vehicle, and one number
12 plate to be attached at the rear of said trailer and it shall always
13 be plainly visible.

1 SECTION 2. Section 6A of Chapter 90 of the General Laws is
2 hereby repealed.
